





Small Investors

They also plan to look for government subsidies for acquisitions in Canada and the USA and for global advantage, selling to investors worldwide in stages.

by making partnerships or mergers, etc. A few years ago, a broker did the sale of IPO shares at auctions. Maybe the best way is to do it privately as it is faster and easier by obtaining permission from the FCC and AMF. If few companies are raising funds, it could be done per episode every week. They plan to make preapproved forms for legal aspects of fundraising, and for episodes, they can make an online mortgage model through a broker who submits it to a few banks that respond within 24 hours, pre-approved like Shark Tank's offers before due diligence. They can consolidate several markets according to the companies available for sale at biz brokers or those who register.

Future Opportunities (Continued)

They plan to take their companies as a test to begin with, writing to all brokers asking for their companies for sale without disclosing names. They will also write to members of sites such as Pwc that Sylvain gave them to see if they are interested. The advantage is that by announcing the company for sale on TV, more people will see it. They can merge two economies of scale, thus creating more value for both. They will take commission either as part of the agent's or the entire commission if direct.

Why TV?

- Allows us to promote the companies to a large audience.
- Gives credibility to the companies.
- Invite personalities to the show (find manager, large companies, political personalities).
- Get the project known quickly and snowball effect.
- Differentiate us from other M&A companies by great visibility.
- Invite successful entrepreneurs to invest, merge, etc. with candidate companies and be on their board. Ex.:
- Government will be happy to share how they participated to the success by subsidies, etc...

We will organize roadshows for best companies to the USA for a fee or % shares.
